

TOUR OF POLAND August 18 – 28, 2008

To make the trip more interesting for participants from abroad, the Association is planning a 10 day Bus Tour of Poland following the Reunion 2008. You will discover the country of your forefathers travelling in a modern air-conditioned coach, staying in comfortable accommodations and tasting traditional Polish foods.

Program for the Tour of Poland

Day I, 18/08/2008 (Monday) Guided tour of Warsaw

After breakfast, travel to Warsaw, where you visit the Royal Palace, followed by a walking tour of Old Town and the Market Place.

Lunch in a café on the Market Place (not included in the price)

On the way back to Konstancja Hotel, we will drive through some of the most interesting districts of Warsaw, around Belweder Palace and Lazienki.

After dinner, showing of the movie "Pan Tadeusz" with English subtitles.

Spend the night at Hotel Konstancja

Day II, 19/08/2008 (Tuesday) Travel to the Baltic

After breakfast travel to Sopot, a seashore resort by the Baltic (230 km.) with lunch on the way (not included in price)

Arrival in Sopot, registration in hotel Villa Aqua www.villaaqua.pl located near the beach; dinner at the Hotel followed by free evening.

Day III, 20/08/2008 (Wednesday) Visit of Gdańsk

Guided tour of Old Town, including Historic City Hall and Market Place followed by free time to shop for souvenirs and look around.

Lunch at the Hotel (included in price)

Relaxing afternoon at the beach or enjoy windsurfing

Dinner at the Hotel followed by free evening

Day IV, 21/08/2008 (Thursday) Visit of Malbork

Travel to Malbork (60 km.) to visit the fortress made famous by the Teutonic Knights with lunch on the premises (not included in the price)

Dinner and evening with local Family members at the Hotel

Day V, 22/08/2008 (Friday) Gdańsk, birthplace of Solidarność

After breakfast visit the THREE CROSSES and the Solidarność museum

Lunch at the Hotel (included in the price)

In the afternoon relax at the beach or enjoy windsurfing

Dinner at the hotel followed by a Jazz concert

Day VI, 23/08/2008, (Saturday) Travel to Zamość

Travel to Zamość (250 km.), birthplace of the Zamoyski Family, closely linked with the Tarnowskis; the city is a jewel of renaissance architecture, built in XVI century by Jan Hetman Zamoyski under the direction of an Italian architect, Bernardo Morando.

Lunch on the way (not included in the price);

On arrival register at Hotel SENATOR near the Main Market Place www.senatorhotel.pl

Festive Dinner in the Hotel's charming cellar restaurant and attended by Marcin Zamoyski, the Mayor of Zamosc, accompanied by his wife Ala.

Day VII, 24/08/2008 (Sunday) Visit of Zamość and travel to Tarnobrzeg

Guided walk around the Old Town and the Main Market Place and a special tour of Historic City Hall with the Mayor (Marcin Zamoyski)

Lunch outdoors in one of the charming cafes on the Main Market Place

Travel to Tarnobrzeg and register at Kameleon Hotel, www.hotelkameleon.pl/index.html

Enjoy a traditional Polish BBQ dinner at one of the Hotel's private halls.

Day VIII, 25/08/2008 (Monday) Visit Dzików, cradle of the Tarnowski Family

Visit the castle and Tarnobrzeg, followed by a luncheon (not included in price)

Travel to Kraków (180 km.) with a short stop over at the Cathedral in Tarnów to visit the tomb of Jan Hetman Tarnowski, most illustrious of our forefathers

Register at hotel Wilga www.hotel.wilga.krakow.pl, enjoy dinner and a relaxing evening

Day IX, 26/08/2008 (Tuesday) Visit of Kraków, the Historical Capital of Poland

Guided visit of Wawel castle, the Old Town, Main Market Place including Sukiennice and Mariacki Cathedral

Lunch at one of the charming cafes on the Main Market (not included in the price)

Dinner and evening with local Family members at a popular restaurant "Polskie Jadło" serving typical Polish food

Day X, 27/08/2008 (Wednesday) Visit of Wieliczka and return to Warsaw

After an early breakfast, we collect our suitcases and travel to Wieliczka for a guided tour of the old and historic salt mine

For a special outdoor lunch of Barbequed sausages and baked potatoes on an open fire (Polish way) we will stop at Folwark Zalesie in Grajów (included in the price)

Travel back to Warsaw (200km.) and register at the Airport Novotel Hotel
